Champagne, NV

The blend is dominated, up to 75% by the two Pinot varieties, namely Meunier and Noir, with the balance taken up by Chardonnay. Floral notes, citrus fruit and freshness from first to final sip. A champagne of elegance and finesse.

**DOMAINE VIEUX TELEGRAPHE
CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE** 268
Rhone, 2014

This is one of the southern Rhone's greatest wine estates and has been in the Brunier Family since 1891. The average age of the vines to produce this white CdP is 45 years. They are, in approximate percentages, 40% Clairette, 25% Grenache Blanc, 25% Roussane and 10% Bourboulenc.

LA VIEILLE FERME 88
Cotes-du-Luberon, 2014

The Old Farm' is a wine belonging to one of Chateauneuf-du-Pape's most respected producers, Chateau de Beaucastel. About medium-bodied, the fruit is wrapped in freshness. Produced from a blend of Bourboulenc, Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc and Vermentino (also known as Rolle).

SIMONNET-FEVBRE CHABLIS 98
Chablis, 2013

This is a house based, and specializes, in Chablis which, by regulation, is 100% Chardonnay. The soil composition of this northern part of Burgundy is the famous Kimmerigdian limestone which gives the wine a great purity, minerality and elegance of fruit. There is also a delicate appley aspect. Average age of the vines is 35 years.

Great cuisine deserves equally stunning wines. Famous for its unique white Alba truffle, Piedmont in northern Italy has Barolo and Barbaresco for red and Arneis, sometimes referred to as the 'White Barolo'. The best Arneis comes from Roero. Unoaked, fresh and fruity, this is very engaging on its own and with food, including seafood, pork and chicken. Michele Chiarlo is dedicated to the traditional varietals of Piedmont including, of course, Arneis.

M3 Chardonnay, sourced from cool vineyards in the Adelaide Hills, is very much in an elegant Burgundian style. Incidentally, Hill Smith, Australia's first Master of Wine, is a consultant to Singapore Airlines.

This Haut-Medoc property on the Left Bank in Bordeaux has a history dating back to the 17th Century. The Gautreau Family purchased it in 1969 and has painstakingly restored it from 8 to 85 hectares of vineyards planted to 48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 47% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc.

The beautiful island of Sardinia is home to this Italian red, a blend of 60% Carignano (Carignan in French), 10% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc and 10% Merlot. Fermented in stainless steel tank the ageing after that is for 15 months in French barrels, 10% being new oak.

GRANT BURGE, FILSELL, SHIRAZ 158
Barossa, 2013

Filsell was planted in 1920 and the vines are now near 100 years old. Considered one of the best vineyards in the Barossa, it produces Shiraz of great intensity, concentration and complexity. Fans of Grant Burge will know that Filsell is considered the younger brother of their other iconic wine Meshach. The wine was aged for between 16 and 18 months in a combination of French and American oak.

Stag's Leap is one of Napa Valley's most illustrious wineries. Named for the Greek goddess of the hunt, Artemis is a blend of 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Merlot and 2% Malbec and aged for 18 months in a combination of new and used French and American oak. Medium-bodied with cherry, berry, plum fruit and vanilla notes.

Deep coloured red that impresses with its balance and intensity of fruit.
